Victoria's 12 part mass Laetatus sum

a workshop for voices and instruments directed by Philip Thorby

At Epping Hall, St John's Road, Epping CM16 5JU

Saturday 19th May 2018 10.00 for 10.30 until 5pm

Victoria's magnificent mass Laetatus sum is in 12 parts in three choirs and is based on his own setting of psalm 22, which we shall also study. This joyful text seems appropriate for a workshop on the day of the royal wedding (and the cup final!). Applications are invited from singers, and from players of appropriate instruments such as cornetts, sackbuts, curtals, recorders, strings and continuo. Pitch will be A = 440.

Philip Thorby is well known to Forum members for the many enjoyable and instructive workshops he has directed for us. He was for many years Director of Early Music at Trinity College of Music and is now a freelance performer and conductor.

Epping is in Essex but at the end of the Central Line, near the M25 and the M11, so should be a convenient venue for members of both TVEMF and EEMF. The hall is in the town centre and according to Google Maps is a 12-minute walk from the station. The 420 and 420A buses cover part of the route. There are two disabled parking spaces at the hall and room to park to drop off instruments and passengers. Parking is at the nearby Bakers Lane public car park and should only cost £1 for the day. There will be a link to a map of the venue on the TVEMF web site www.tvemf.org.

The day will start with coffee and biscuits at 10am and music will start at 10.30. Please bring your own lunch or find a café in the town. There will be a break for tea during the afternoon.

The cost for this workshop is £14 for Early Music Forum members and £16 for non-members. Please apply as early as possible. You can assume that you have been accepted unless you hear to the contrary by the closing date, 12th May. Applications may be accepted after this date but the cost will increase by £2. If you find you cannot come, please be sure to let us know in good time. Don't just fail to turn up as not only will we keep your payment but you may deprive someone on the waiting list of a place.
